- congregational buildings in the Bagan architectural site, three pagodas with the nagayon' motif can be seen. These are-
- Nagayon pagoda (#1192) circa11AD located east of the Apeyadana pagoda in the area south of Myingaba village.
- The Nagayon pagoda with a circular plinth (#1300) (2)circa 11AD located south east of Myingaba village. (3) The southern one (#40) circa 15 AD out of the two
- pagodas on the bank of the Aveyarwady river located northeast of the Shwezigon stupa.

Of these three, the one mentioned as serial number (1) in the above list, the Nagayon Pagoda (#1192) will be the subject of this presentation.
