Answer - 1= Page 19 19

The truth of after-life should be convinced by considering the inequalities in business, professions, education, intelligence etc. among people and differences in temperaments, tendencies and habits of the same family members, which are stated by the Buddha's Teaching as due to Kamma (action), thoughts and tendencies of past-existences.

(B) Question - 2= Is killing germs Pāṇātipātā offence? page 60.

Answer - 2= page 60-63

The most important of all is the motive or mental attitude. If the medicines are given with the sole intention of alleviating or removing the patient's

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living beings and to kill them, it should not be taken as Pāṇātipātā offence.

(C) Question - 3= Page 64-73

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So, by considering the above mentioned reasons, it should be noted that certain extraordinary cases of longevity in non-Buddhist countries are related to past Kamma, hereditary, nutriment, seasons, habits, and less mental stress.

For Buddhists, meritoious deeds regarding the triple Gems (Tiratana) should also be taken into account.

Thus, most venerable Mahāsi Mahathera had expounded in reply to the questions with regard to " The Problems of life" posed to him.

To summarize :-

Heedfully contemplating the lord Buddha's admonishment:-

" Vaya dhammā Sankhārā, appamādena sampādetha " meaning " Everything that arises is subject to dissolution, strive with diligence ".

" Manussatta bhavo dullabo" :-

Human existence is hard to achieve
