

What is Nibbāna?

- When Defilements (*Kiṃva-*) and Aggregates (*Khandhā*) become extinct without any remainder, never to reappear, it is peace—by sign as well as by nature.
- Here, dissolution is not concerned with *Baṅga* phenomenon, Death (*māraṇa*), or Impermanence (*anicca*). It is parting ways with any more appearance or birth (*uppāda-jāti*). Nibbāna is an extinction (*Nirodha*) to be differentiated from the above three kinds of dissolution.
- For every genuine Buddhist's need, to know of the nature and characteristics of Nibbāna. The *Ledi Dhammā on Nibbāna*, compiled in gist from *Ledi Mahāthera's Nibbāna Dīpanī*, *Nibbāna Vissajjanā* and *Ledi Nibbān* treatise, is now being distributed for your appreciation.
